You Were Chosen on Purpose!

“Paul, an apostle - sent not from men nor by man, but by Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him from the dead...”

Galatians 1:1

- God chose Paul to minister to the Gentiles in the 1st century.
- This makes sense, Paul was amazing
- **You** have been **sent** by God. God has **chosen you!**

Paul wasn't good enough

- Watches the stoning of Stephen. (Acts 7:58)
- Acts 9 he is “still breathing out murderous threats.”
- Saul/Paul in complete opposition to God.
- “Saint Paul” or “Chief of Sinners”

Galatians 1:11-17

“I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel I preached is not of human origin. I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it; rather, I received it by revelation.

For you have heard of my previous way of life in Judaism, **how intensely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it.** I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my own age among my people and was extremely zealous for the traditions of my fathers. **But when God, who set me apart from my mother’s womb and called me by his grace, was pleased to reveal his Son in me so that I might preach him among the Gentiles...**”

- God chooses Gideon to save Israel.
- Gideon hiding in a winepress




Gideon was hiding in a winepress maybe like this one.

Gideon

- “The Lord is with you mighty warrior!”
- Gideon had some doubts:
 - How can I save Israel?
 - My clan is the weakest in Manasseh.
 - I am the least in my family.
 - A round loaf of barley
- Gideon raises up a big army
- God whittles down the army to 300
- Gideon leads the Israelites to victory

Peter was a failure

- One of the first disciples
- Saw Jesus heal his mother-in-law
- Peter walked on the water, then
- Declared, “You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God!”
- Mount of Transfiguration
- Peter was passionate
- Matthew 26
 - “Even if all fall away on account of you, I never will!”
 - “This very night, before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times.”
